## DISCLOSURES OF PECUNIARY INTERESTS AND OTHER MATTERS

### **GOVERNMENT INFORMATION (PUBLIC ACCESS) ACT 2009**

#### **Section 6 Mandatory proactive release of certain government information**

(4) An agency must facilitate public access to open access information contained in a record by deleting matter from a copy of the record to be made publicly available if inclusion of the matter would otherwise result in there being an overriding public interest against disclosure of the record and it is practicable to delete the matter.

#### **Section 14 Public interest considerations against disclosure**

There is a public interest consideration against disclosure of information if disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to have one or more of the following effects—

##### **: 3 Individual rights, judicial processes and natural justice**

(a) reveal an individual's personal information

(f) expose a person to a risk of harm or of serious harassment or serious intimidation

##### **: 4 Business interests of agencies and other persons**

(d) prejudice any person's legitimate business, commercial, professional or financial interests

### **LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993**

#### **Section 739 Protection of privacy**

(1) A person may request that any material that is available (or is to be made available) for public inspection by or under this Act be prepared or amended so as to omit or remove any matter that would disclose or discloses the person's place of living if the person considers that the disclosure would place or places the personal safety of the person or of members of the person's family at risk.

### **PRIVACY AND PERSONAL INFORMATION PROTECTION ACT 1998**

#### **Section 58 Suppression of personal information**

(1) A person about whom personal information is contained (or proposed to be contained) in a public register may request the public sector agency responsible for keeping the register to have the information:

(a) removed from, or not placed on, the register as publicly available, and

(b) not disclosed to the public.

(2) If the public sector agency is satisfied that the safety or well-being of any person would be affected by not suppressing the personal information as requested, the agency must suppress the information in accordance with the request unless the agency is of the opinion that the public interest in maintaining public access to the information outweighs any individual interest in suppressing the information.

(3) Any information that is removed from, or not placed on, a public register under this section may be kept on the register for other purposes.
